Sudbury Water Miradours and Belle Vue Park

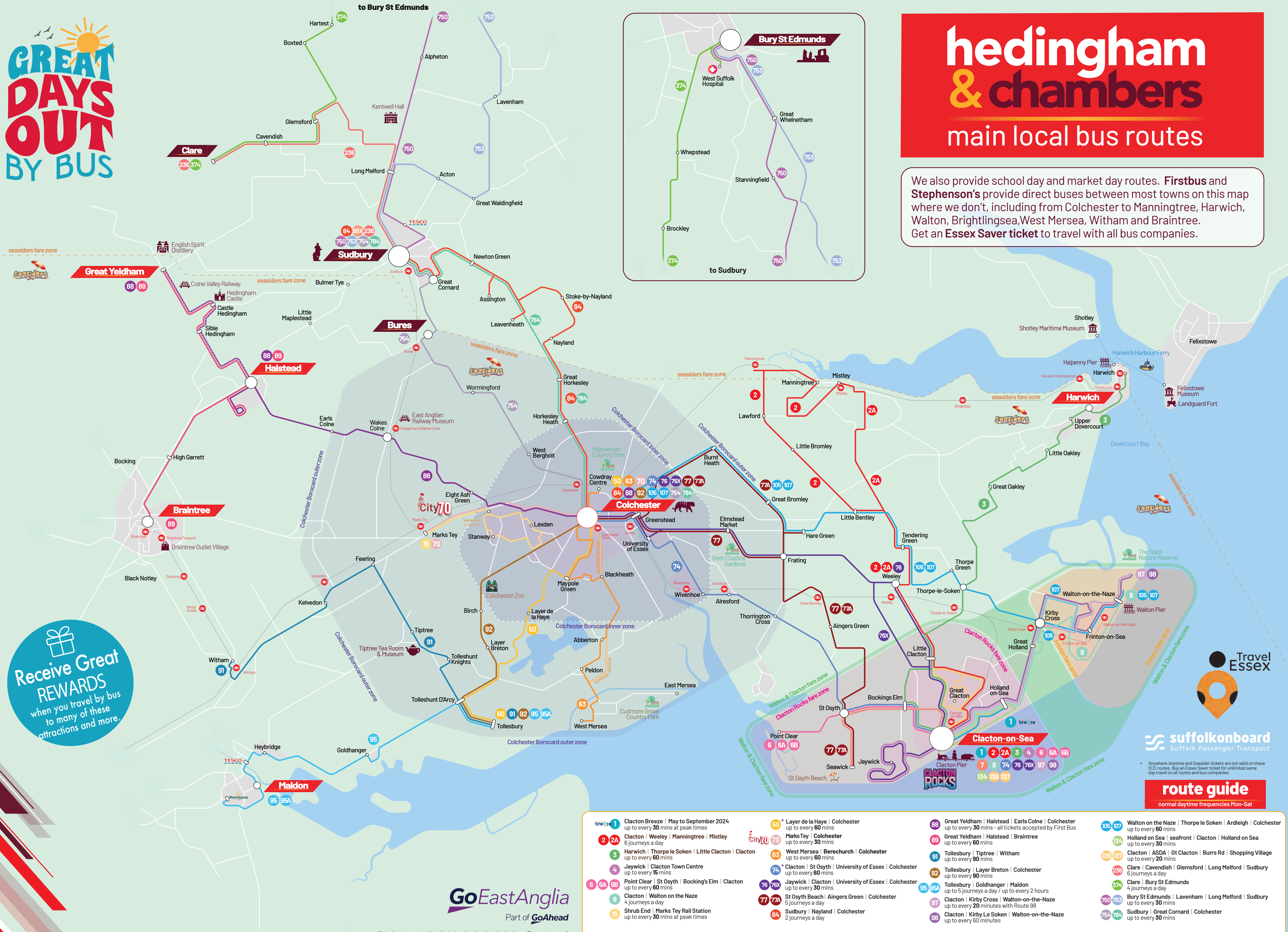
